**What does Jesus expect of His church?**

1 Peter 2:9-10

<sup>9</sup>But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. <sup>10</sup>Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

- **Proclaim** = includes a person's **attitudes, actions and words**

**Don't judge One Another**

**Don't deprive One Another of physical intimacy**

**Don't grumble among One Another**

**Don't pass judgement on One Another**

Romans 14:1

<sup>1</sup>As for the one who is weak in faith, welcome him, but not to quarrel over opinions. <sup>2</sup>One person believes he may eat anything, while the weak person eats only vegetables. <sup>3</sup>Let not the one who eats despise the one who abstains, and let not the one who abstains **pass judgment** on the one who eats, for God has welcomed him. <sup>4</sup>Who are you to **pass judgment** on the servant of another? It is before his own master that he stands or falls. And he will be upheld, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

**Opinions - Disputable matters**

**Don't deprive One Another of physical intimacy**

1 Cor 7:1-5

Now concerning the matters about which you wrote: "It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman." <sup>2</sup>But because of the temptation to sexual immorality, each man should have his own wife and each woman her own husband. <sup>3</sup>The husband should give to his wife her conjugal rights, and likewise the wife to her husband. <sup>4</sup>For the wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does. <sup>5</sup>Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

**Don't grumble among One Another**

In John 6:41-43

<sup>41</sup>So the Jews grumbled about him, because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven." <sup>42</sup>They said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" <sup>43</sup>Jesus answered them, "Do not grumble among yourselves."

**Grumbled** = whispering with rebellious feelings

**Confusion + Offense** = Grumbling
