
Serve and Share (S2) Reflection and Action:

Prepare: Listen to the sermon (if you haven't already), read Proverbs 26:4-5 and Isaiah 11:2, and spend a few minutes praying for your group.

Connect:

What's a (fun) unpopular opinion you hold that many others disagree with?

Discuss:

HEAD: WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY?

- 1. What stood out to you about this week's sermon?
- 2.Read Proverbs 26:4-5 aloud as a group. How do these verses reshape the way we view right and wrong?
- 3.Read Colossians 4:5-6 aloud as a group. What does this call believers to in our interaction with the wider culture?
 - a .How have you seen this done well?

HEART: HOW DOES THIS CHANGE MY ATTITUDES AND AFFECTIONS?

- 1. Think of a recent conversation where you wish you had stayed silent or spoken up. Why did you choose that response?
 - a. What did your chosen response reveal about the idols that may have rule in your heart?
 - b. What would a Spirit-led, wise response have looked like in that conversation?
- 2. Where do you most need the wisdom of Jesus to guide you right now at home, at work, in friendships, etc.?
 - a. Read Galatians 5:22-23 aloud as a group. What would it look like for Jesus' wisdom to shape these interactions instead of our own temperament?

HANDS: WHAT IS THIS PASSAGE ASKING US TO DO?

1. Think of a person you regularly disagree with. How can you engage them this week not to win, but to love them and seek their good?
