HEART: HOW DOES THIS CHANGE MY ATTITUDES AND AFFECTIONS?

1. How have you experienced a fear of people, or has their approval impacted your obedience to God's call or your spiritual convictions?

2. What parts of your identity have been competing with Jesus for defining who you are?
