## The Week of September 13, 2026

Growth Groups, or G2s, are a small group of people who meet weekly to study, share, and support one another in their Christian lives. This is the main way that we connect, study the Bible together, and grow as a community where we are known and cared for. These questions are designed to guide you in your weekly G2 gathering. Check out open groups online!



**Big Idea:** God designed people to yearn for a vision

**Prepare:** Listen to the sermon (if you haven't already), read Proverbs 3 and spend a few minutes praying for your group.

**Connect:** What is something you're looking forward to right now, big or small?

**Discuss:**

**TRUTH: What does God's Word say?**

1. Read Romans 12:1-2 aloud as a group. How is biblical transformation different from simply becoming a nicer or more disciplined person?
2. Read John 7:37-39 aloud as a group. Why must we first receive love from Christ before we can truly overflow to others?
3. Compare Matthew 5:14-16 with the idea of "Everywhere Always". What can our lives communicate to the people around us?

**TRANSFORMATION: What is God changing in me?**

1. Shawn described transformation as, "different this week than last, this month than last, this year than last." Where is God currently working on you?

**COMMUNITY: What does this look like among us?**

1. How can our group become a place where people are comfortable saying, "Here is an area where I am not yet who Jesus is calling me to be"?
2. Imagine our growth group one year from now. What evidence would there be that we hadn't simply studied this vision but were actually living it together?

**MISSION: How do we live this out in the world?**

1. Where has God placed you (at work, school, in your neighborhood, gym, sports, or family) where you have relationships with people who may never step into a church?
2. Think practically: What could it look like to overflow God's love in one of those circles this week? Pray: God, help me overflow your love today
